## Joint Spring 2021 Symposium - Publication Announcement

To mark the 25th anniversary of the 1996 Telecommunications Act, the Federal Communications Law Journal hosted at The George Washington University Law School (FCLJ) and the Berkeley Center for Law & Technology (BCLT) hosted a joint virtual Spring 2021 Symposium, 25th Anniversary of the Telecommunications Act of 1996—What's Next? (Symposium) on March 12, 2021.

Panelists who participated in this Joint Symposium are encouraged to submit their final works for publication consideration in two Journals dedicating their issues to the Symposium.

## **Opportunity for Publication**

Authors of Symposium articles have two opportunities for publication: (1) the Federal Communications Law Journal and (2) the Berkeley Technology Law Journal (BTLJ).

To be considered for publication in the 2021 FCLJ Symposium Issue, authors must submit their papers for consideration by **May 1, 2021** to <u>fcljarticles@law.gwu.edu</u>. FCLJ encourages submissions of about or under 20 pages but does not have a page limit. The FCLJ anticipates a publication of this issue in 2021.

To be published in the BTLJ Special Symposium Issue (which will include all publishable articles as decided by BTLJ in addition to those previously published with FCLJ) authors should submit their papers by **August 1, 2021.** These submissions should likewise be 20 pages or less. BTLJ anticipates publication of this special issue in 2022.
